Following on from the updates that we sent you last week, we wanted to provide some further updates on the following:

75% grant for subsequent properties now available

- Applies to those in the hospitality, leisure or retail sectors.
- From 5 May 2020, small business ratepayers will be eligible for an additional 75% grant on subsequent properties.
- Applications to be made to the local authority.

Bounce back loans for small businesses (BBLS)

- A loan of up to £50,000 capped at 25% of turnover.
- Guaranteed by the UK government, who will also pay the interest costs for the first 12 months.
- Designed to provide working capital to help get your business trading again quickly, by minimising the application criteria and time taken to receive funding.
- Not available to those in receipt of a CBILS loan, however a CBILS loan of under £50,000 can be converted into a BBLs loan.
- Apply via an accredited lender.

Pivotal Enterprise Resilience Fund – Expected to resume next week

- For businesses that are vital to the local, regional or national economy.
- Emphasis on businesses with links to key workers and key sectors.
- The fund was paused on 5 May due to the volume of applications, however is expected to resume next week.
- Fill in the Scottish Government's Eligibility Checker to obtain an application form.

Self-employed Income Support Scheme (SEISS) - Opening 12 May 2020

- A grant of 80% of self-employed profits, capped at £2,500 per month. The scheme is open for an initial three months.
- For self-employed individuals (operating as sole traders or in a partnership).
- A 2018/19 tax return must have been filed, with self-employed income constituting more than 50% of total income.
- Trading profits must be less than £50,000.
- <u>Check your eligibility</u> and ensure you have a <u>government gateway personal tax</u> account, which applications must be made through.
